

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS FOR FOOD, PRODUCE AND BEVERAGE STALL HOLDERS

Food, produce and beverage stall holders are also required to:

- Comply with the requirements of the NSW Food Authority Temporary Event guideline, NSW Food Authority Mobile Vending Guidelines, Food Act 2003, Food Regulation 2015 and the Food Standards Code. A routine inspection will be conducted by Council's Environmental Health Officer who is authorised to issue any necessary enforcement action as required.
- A food safety supervisor is to be appointed. A copy of the Food Safety Supervisor certificate must be available on-site and upon request of Council's Environmental Health Officer.
- Ensure all pre-packed foods meet the packaging and labelling requirements of the Australia New Zealand Food Standards Code, chapter 1 General Food Standards, part 1.2 Labelling and other information requirements (foodstandards.gov.au).
- MVIC will conduct random inspections of sites and those not complying with stallholder terms and conditions will be closed down.
- Stall holders shall be bound by the MVIC terms and conditions outlined in this document. Stall holders not abiding by these terms and conditions will not be permitted to remain on-site.
- All staff manning stalls selling or supplying alcohol must hold a current RSA competency card. Copies of this card must be provided with your Public Liability Insurance prior to the event.
- A not-for-profit group has been approached to sell bottled water and soft drink at the event. No other stall is permitted to sell bottled water or soft drink unless approved by MVIC.
- All beverages sold in the provided 285ml event glass will be sold to the public for \$5 unless prior approval has been granted by MVIC.
- Food outlets with a deep fryer must have a dry chemical powder fire extinguisher on-site

STALL DEFINITIONS

FOOD

Any item proposed for and/or sold at the event with the expectation of immediate human consumption and which is either prepared on-site or prepared off-site and brought to the event prepackaged.

PRODUCE STALL

Any food item proposed for sale without the expectation of immediate human consumption. Produce is prepared off-site and brought to the event prepackaged.

BEVERAGES

Any hot or cold non-alcoholic beverage item whether made on-site or prepackaged. Examples include coffee, soft drink, water and shaved ice.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE

(beer or wine)

Any alcoholic beer or wine beverage item. Special conditions apply.

All alcoholic beverage stalls must provide RSA trained staff and evidence of current certificates/cards must be forwarded to MVIC no less than two weeks prior to the event.

Alcoholic beverages are only to be served from the official tasting glasses for each event. Where stall holders are provided with official tasting glasses to sell, stall holders will be required to reimburse MVIC for all glasses sold.

GENERAL STALL

Any item which does not fall into any other category.
